



## **Child & Family Services Opening Assistant Cook**

**Responsibilities:** The person in this position works as part of the kitchen and site team and is responsible for assisting with preparation of high quality meals for children ages 0-5, food safety/sanitation, knowledge/use of kitchen equipment and delivery of food and supplies to assigned centers.

**Requirements:** High school diploma or equivalent and 2 years experience in quantity food preparation; Serve Safe Certification preferred; basic knowledge of nutritional needs of children; ability to relate positively to children and adults; ability to organize and oversee kitchen duties; ability to lift 50 pound containers and packages, ability to pass a physical examination, State Bureau of Investigation, Department of Health and Human Services, Department of Motor Vehicle, Fraud and National Sex Offender Registry background checks; regularly required to sit, speak, listen, stand, walk, reach with hands and arms, stoop, kneel or crouch; must possess a valid driver's license and have use of a vehicle insured to State of Maine requirements.

Part-time benefits include paid holidays, bi-weekly accrual of Paid Time Off, employer sponsored retirement plan, health, life, dental/vision, and disability insurance options.
