Responsibilities include leadership and coordination of education programs for children using evidence-based instructional practices to continuously improve teaching and learning to accelerate children's development and support school readiness outcomes. Duties include oversight of integrated service delivery, organizational support, reflective supervision to promote a culture of professionalism and collaboration within interdisciplinary teams, and coaching to foster high quality teaching practices, assessment and implementation of curriculum.

Requirements include Bachelor's Degree in Early Care & Education or related field (Master's preferred) and 5 years paid experience in Early Care and Education (birth-age 5) with 3 years' experience in a leadership role. Must be able to meet requirements of agency & State Child Care Licensing regulations for background checks and physical exams. Must demonstrate strong skills in; interpersonal work, written & verbal communication, documentation, critical thinking, group management, and computer proficiency. Position may require occasional travel out of state.
