

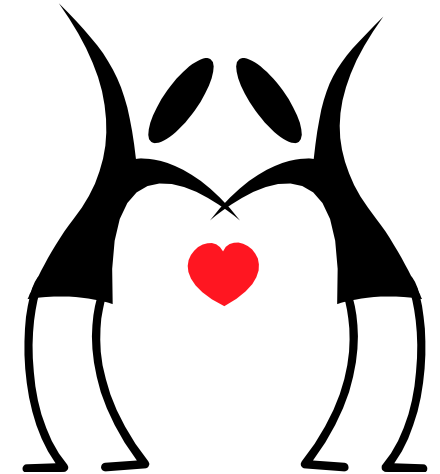

Kids First is a one day, four hour workshop which is designed to help parents address problems and promote reduction of the negative effects of divorce.

All workshops are held on Saturdays from

The workshop will address:

- Children's needs as marital and family roles change
- The effects of divorce on children and children's reaction to divorce.
