

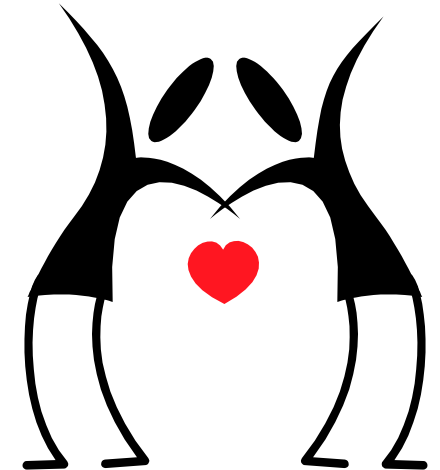

# What is Kids First <sup>SM</sup>?

**Kids First <sup>SM</sup>** is a one day, four hour workshop which is designed to help parents address problems and promote reduction of the negative effects of divorce.

The workshop will address:

- Children's needs as marital and family roles change
- The effects of divorce on children and children's reaction to divorce
- Making decisions about parenting arrangements
- Dealing with conflict without involving children
- Helping children adjust to differences between households

Participants are encouraged to attend the program as early in the separation or divorce process as possible.

Child care is not available and program is for adults only.
