Community Initiatives

Our Health Navigator program educated more than **2,000** people on the **Affordable Care Act**.



**272**

uninsured people purchased **health insurance** through the new Marketplace.

**102** youth are members of the **South End Teen Center**.

**100%** completed the **school year**.

**50%** participated in **community service projects**.



**105** people received help **finding a job** through **KVCAP Employment Services**.



KVCAP helped organize **14 job fairs & informational sessions** with local partners, reaching over **1,000** people.

Energy & Housing

We helped **39** people **purchase their own home** and **26** homeowners **avoid foreclosure**.



KVCAP coordinated the distribution of food to **38** food banks and soup kitchens providing **219,696** meals and **33,300** boxes of food.

**18,500** people were **warmer last winter** because of our **heating assistance program**.

**249** furnaces were serviced or replaced and

**61** homes were **weatherized**, helping homeowners save money.

**Health & safety risks** were repaired in **122** homes.



**34** seniors lived at the newly renovated **Gerald Hotel** affordable housing project.

Social Services

The Family Enrichment Council works to **prevent child abuse** and neglect in Kennebec and Somerset counties.

**4,000** kids took part in **personal body safety classes**.



**Maine Families Home Visiting** works in partnership with expectant parents and parents of babies and toddlers to ensure safe home environments and **promote healthy growth and development**.



**341** families were connected with a **home visitor**.  
**100%** of children were up-to-date on their **immunizations**.  
**87%** of pregnant moms received adequate **prenatal care**.

Transportation

The **Kennebec & Somerset Explorer** public bus system gave **94,344** rides, helping people get to work, to retail shops, attend cultural events and more.

That's a **30% increase** in two years!

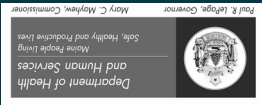
