Requirements are Educational Technician certification per Chapter 115 of the Maine Department of Education and have applicable education based on the requirements of Ed Tech II (60 hours of approved study) or Ed Tech III (90 hours of approved study) in an educationally related field. Experience in group care setting for young children preferred. Must be able to meet requirements of agency & State Child Care Licensing regulations for background checks and physical exams. Must demonstrate strong interpersonal, communication (written & verbal) and documentation skills, critical thinking skills, basic computer skills, and group management skills.
