Energy & Housing

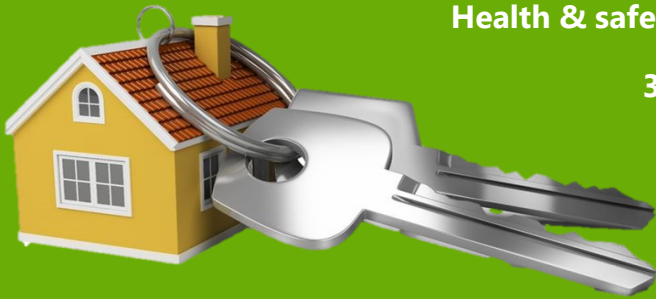
12,866 people stayed warm because of our **Fuel Assistance Program**.

Health & safety risks were repaired in **28 homes**.

356 people had their **furnace serviced or replaced**.

65 homes were **weatherized**.

We helped **145 people purchase a home**, and **10 homeowners avoid foreclosure**.



Social Services

Maine Families Home Visiting partners with expecting or new parents of babies and toddlers to ensure safe home environments, and promote healthy growth & development.



283 families connected with a home visitor.

2,939 home visits

Family Enrichment Council works to prevent child abuse in Kennebec & Somerset counties.



459 local service providers attended KVCAP-facilitated **Mandated Reporter** training.

Community Initiatives

68 youth were South End Teen Center **members**.

91% completed the school year

9 got part-time **jobs**.

42 volunteered in the community.



The Kennebec and Somerset **Poverty Action Coalitions** are grassroots groups that work with KVCAP to create solutions to the **barriers to prosperity**.

53 Community Investors in Kennebec County raised over **\$22K**. They helped **40 families** access basic essentials when there were **NO** other resources.



We helped **111 uninsured people** get health insurance.



KVCAP and partners held **6 job fairs**, over **450 people** attended.

Resource Navigators connected **243 people** to a variety of services, providing case management in times of financial crisis.

In Somerset County, **Community Investors** raised over \$3,000 helping 11 families access basic resources.

Child & Family Services

577 children (birth – 5 years) increased their **readiness for school success**.

568,414 hours of quality early care and education services were provided.



92,431 healthy meals and snacks were served.

527 parents improved their **parenting skills**.

Community child care providers received over **5,100 hours** of training and technical support from KVCAP.



Transportation



Kennebec/Somerset Explorer public buses gave **90,835 rides** bringing people to work, learn, shop, access health care, and more.

KV Van and volunteer drivers provided **195,756 rides** bringing people to health-related appointments.
