We are looking for someone with previous work experience with children and families, experience facilitating groups and willingness to work flexible working hours, such as occasional evenings and weekends as necessary. Working knowledge of local resources for families and effective written and strong verbal communication skills are a necessity. is responsible for implementing strategies to prevent, address and reduce child abuse and neglect within Somerset County.

Requirements: Bachelor's Degree in Human Services and/or experience in Social Services, family studies or other related field. Ability to work with a wide variety of people in different circumstances and culturally diverse populations as well as the ability to have a flexible schedule.
