**Requirements** are a Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education, Social work or related field **and** a minimum of one year paid experience working with young children, birth to 6 years old. Previous Case Management and home visiting experience preferred. Must demonstrate strong interpersonal, communication (written & verbal) and documentation skills as well as critical thinking skills and proficiency with using computer programs including Word and Excel. Must also possess a valid driver's license and have use of a vehicle insured to State of Maine requirements; ability to pass State Bureau of Investigation, Department of Health and Human Services, Department of Motor Vehicle, National Sex Offender Registry and Fraud background checks.
