This position oversees 7-9 staff in two distinct programs: Resource Navigation, providing a continuum of services including: Information/Referral; Emergency Assistance; and Case Management, working with people to develop goal plans aimed at increasing their health, economic stability and well-being. The South End Teen Center offers youth a safe, healthy, supportive after-school environment offering recreation, education/skill building, and connection to wrap-around supports.

In addition to supervising staff, this position focuses on program compliance, include daily approval of emergency assistance expenditures. The Community Services Manager works closely with the Program Director on program planning and community outreach, representing KVCAP on several community coalitions and groups.

Requirements: Bachelor's Degree and five years' experience in Social Services field. Supervisory experience is required. Must demonstrate strong communication skills (both written and verbal), ability to think critically, organizational skills, and proficiency in use of technology, including ability to learn/operate data base systems. Knowledge of area resources is preferred. Must be able to pass SBI, DMV, DHHS, fraud and Sex Offender Registry background checks.
