KVCAP has an opening for a full-time Kennebec Explorer Driver in the Waterville location. Responsibilities include conducting pre and post trip inspections; operating a handicapped accessible bus with a capacity of up to 18 passengers along a regularly schedule route within an assigned area. Position requires moderate twisting, bending, pushing and lifting capabilities.

Requirements: Must be at least twenty-one years of age and possess a valid state of Maine Commercial Drivers License with P endorsement including one-year experience as a licensed driver. Have a good driving record with no serious or recurring moving violations; physically able to assist passengers in and out of the vehicle including passengers using a wide variety of mobility aids including wheelchairs, walkers, motorized three wheeled scooters, etc and may include lifting and carrying parcels up to fifty pounds. Ability to pass an agency approved physical examination and pass background checks including a Department of Motor Vehicle, State Bureau of Investigation, Department of Health and Human Services, National Sex Offender Registry, and Fraud background check. Must also pass an agency approved pre-employment drug screen. Must be able to relate to a wide variety of people and maintain a pleasant atmosphere.
