

Field Inspector

KVCAP's Energy Program has an opening for a full-time Field Inspector to work in Kennebec, Somerset, Sagadahoc and Lincoln counties. The person in this position is responsible for conducting onsite inspections for Central Heating Improvement Program (CHIP)-repair and replacement system installs, Heat Pump installations, Above Ground Storage Tank installs and home repair and weatherization assessments at client homes. This position receives and processes inspection orders for completeness, and documents potential problems and areas of concern as they may arise. Works in accordance within the specified program Guidance and Procedures.

<u>Requirements</u>: Three to five years related work in the residential carpentry, energy conservation, weatherization techniques, local and state building codes, heating systems and rehab techniques preferred. Experience with project estimating in the construction trades; ability to communicate positively with a variety of people; self motivated, possess computer skills and ability to work with minimum supervision. Must have a valid driver's license insured to the State of Maine requirements and ability to travel in four county area. Ability to pass DHHS, DMV, SBI, Fraud and Sex Offender Registry background checks.
