

## **Spare Drivers Needed**

KVCAP's Transportation Program is seeking Spare KV Van and Kennebec Explorer Drivers for our Skowhegan, Augusta and Waterville locations. Spare Drivers work on an on-call or as needed basis, and the positions have the potential to become regular full-time Drivers.

As a KV Van Driver you are required to have a valid Maine driver's license. As a Kennebec Explorer Driver you must possess a Commercial Driver's License with a P endorsement; for either driving position you must be at least twenty-one years of age and have at least one years' experience as a licensed driver; a good driving record with no serious or recurring moving violations. Must be physically able to assist passengers in and out of the vehicle including passengers using a wide variety of mobility aids, (wheelchairs, walkers, motorized three wheeled scooters, etc.) and ability to perform moderate twisting, bending, pushing, lifting and carrying parcels weighing up to fifty pounds.

Additional requirements include the ability to pass an Agency approved physical examination, pre-employment drug screening, and pass DMV, State Bureau of Investigation, Department of Health and Human Services, Fraud and National Sex Offender Registry background checks. You also must be able to relate to a wide variety of people and maintain a pleasant and helpful attitude at all times. Proof of Covid-19 vaccination required.

Spare drivers are eligible for earned paid leave accrual.
